## 2. About the project:

The training has 3 main conceptual blocks: organisational development and impact measurement.

The **organisational development training** part will address the organisational needs of participant organisations in order to strengthen them with learning and exchange by sharing useful tools that they can use for their own organisational development and training. The methodology will be based on the model of the Organisational Pentagon (OP), learnt from Fundacion SES and adapted to the IVS reality by the CCIVS, which allows working and understanding in a very intuitive way the main pilars of organisational health (conceptualised as structure, functioning, sustainability, communication, relations), adapting them to IVS and regional realities, and make a deep needs assessment at the same time that knowledge is acquired. Such analysis give the basis for a strategic planning for the organisation, which will be practised for the most relevant topics in each region.

The **impact research training** block will include the theoretical model developed to create the research, the results obtained and conclusions extracted, and the techniques to implement impact research in an organisation. Participants will experiment the techniques by themselves and with their partners, as a first step before making the practical experience in their countries.







In Macedonia, a training course and a field visit will happen from January  $24^{th}$  – February  $3^{rd}$  2018, which is planned to happen in Etno Selo. The training will be from January  $26^{th}$  (arrival day for participants) to January  $31^{st}$  (departure of participants), whereas the field visit will be from February  $1^{st}$  -  $3^{rd}$ , 2018.

## 3. Tasks and responsibilities

#### 1. Logistics and coordination:

- ✓ Contacting and arranging items instructed by project coordinator inlocal languages;
- ✓ Arranging and coordinating participants' arrivals and departures (local transport);
- ✓ Arranging accommodation, food, venues for training and field visit;
- ✓ Purchasing required materials and other items for the project;
- ✓ Uploading photos and doing social media promotion in English.





## 2. Field-visit support:

- ✓ Organising the field visit in MultiКулти;
- ✓ Supporting the two trainers with the activities in the mobility and the field visit;

- ✓ Translating the interviews in the local languages;
- ✓ Transcribing and translating the interviews in the final phase.
