Center for Intercultural Dialogue presents its latest project: On|Offline: Youth Engagement Using Digital Tools.

This collaborative project involved over 100 participants from Austria, Brazil and North Macedonia and was undertaken by members across three youth-led organizations (Popedu - Austria, Engajamundo - Brazil and The Center for Intercultural Dialogue – North Macedonia) between 2019 and 2022.

Intending to inspire and engage young people, On|Offline explored and analysed online behaviour, digital tools, and the benefits of being connected for individuals and the local community.

Being involved in the decision-making process shapes the global youth in countless ways, from connecting with their environment and building meaningful relationships on a professional and personal level, to developing the ability to make more informed decisions throughout their lives.

As a result, the On|Offline booklet, a collectively produced publication free to download, shares resources, experiences, and inspiration around online tools, best practices and methods for

creating social movement and real-world societal change. This is free to download on the website, designed for Youth organizations to use.

This project was made possible and undertaken as part of the European Commission's Erasmus+ programme for education, training, youth, and sport, focusing on the cooperation and exchange of practices, innovation, and research.
